## **General Call for Papers**

The Bureau of Transportation Statistics, in the Research and Innovative Technology Administration in the US Department of Transportation, is reintroducing the *Journal of Transportation and Statistics (JT&S)*, which is a scholarly, peer-reviewed journal that serves the transportation community by increasing the understanding of the role of transportation in society, its function in the economy, and its interactions with the environment. In addition, the *JT&S* provides a forum for the latest developments in transportation information and data, theory, concepts, and methods of analysis relevant to all aspects of the transportation system. The *JT&S* publishes original research on the use of information to improve public and private decision making for transportation. We are soliciting contributions that broadly support this objective. Examples of the type of material sought include:

- measuring transportation activity and the performance of transportation systems
- quantifying and analyzing the importance of transportation and its consequences
- measuring and analyzing transportation trends
- advancing the science of acquiring, validating, managing and disseminating transportation information
- calculating sustainable energy
- analyzing data for transportation planning and operations
